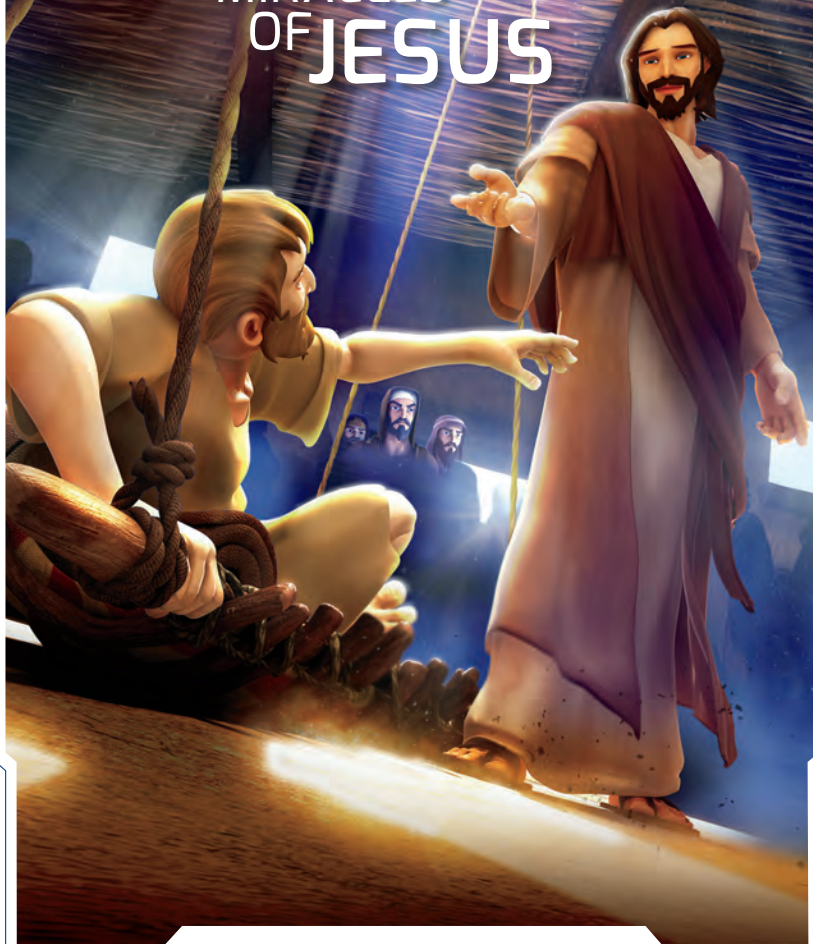

Why do you think Miraculo liked to do magic tricks? Now tell me, why did Jesus do miracles? **Read Matthew 14:14.**

Where does Jesus get His power? **Read Luke 4:14.**

Jesus began His ministry by listing some things God called Him to do. **Read Luke 4:18.**

In your own words, can you say what this means?

Who are some hurting people we should pray for right now?

PRAY Dear Lord, thank You for Your awesome power and for caring about needy people. I pray that You will touch those who are sick and suffering. Amen.



TRUE FAITH

Jesus told a parable about seed that fell in four different places. Can you remember what the seed stands for, and where it fell?

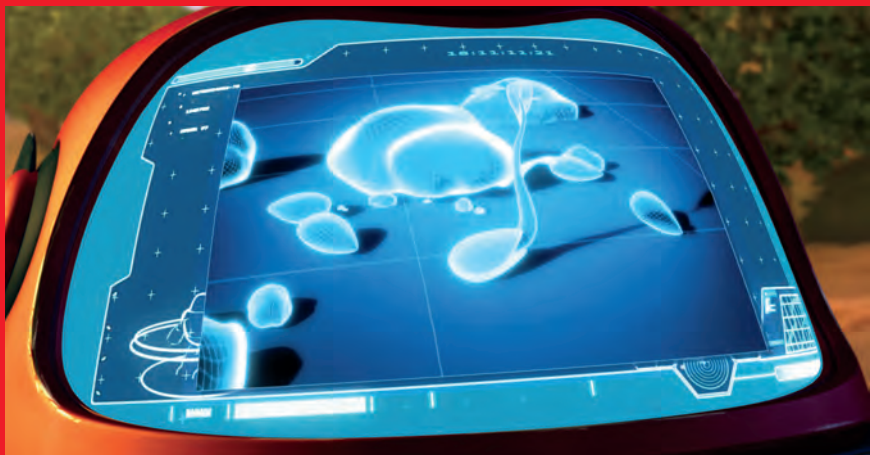
See Luke 8:11-15.

We want our hearts to be “good soil” where the seed of God’s Word will grow and change us. What are some things we can do to grow in our faith? **Read Colossians 2:6-7.**

When the disciples were crossing the stormy sea, who was worried and who wasn’t? **Read Matthew 8:24-26.** What do you think the disciples could have done in the storm if they had more faith?

Is there a situation in your life where you need to trust God today?

PRAY Dear God, I pray that the seed of Your Word will grow in my heart every day. Fill me with faith in You. Amen.



AMAZING MIRACLES

Sometimes we can see that people have physical disabilities—such as being blind or crippled. Other people have sickness on the inside, where we can't see. Which ones do you think Jesus has power over? **Read Matthew 4:23-24.**

The man who lived near the tombs looked scary. Why wasn't Jesus afraid? After the man was healed, what did Jesus tell him to do? **Read Mark 5:19.**

The paralyzed man couldn't walk, so how did he get to see Jesus? **See Mark 2:1-11.**

What do you think would have happened if the paralyzed man didn't have friends to carry him? Do you have any friends who may be able to walk, but still need you to help them find the Lord?

PRAY Dear Jesus, show me how to be a true friend to anyone who needs to know about Your love and power. Amen.
